Roca Inc. is a Chelsea-based, non-profit organization that serves high-risk youth from Chelsea, East Boston, and Revere, MA. We are seeking an ESL Volunteer Educator that is patient, engaging, consistent, and available to work the following hours:

Mondays 7pm-9pm, Tuesdays 10am-12pm, and Wednesdays 7pm-9pm

Job Description:

- Understand, practice, and promote the vision, mission, values, methods, and models of Roca.
- Manage fidelity and quality implementation of Stage-Based Educational Programming.
- Engage with Participants and Educators
 - Engage and build relationships with young people enrolled in Transformational Relationships and participating in stage-based educational and pre-vocational programming.
 - Communicate with Education Program Coordinator regarding participant personal barriers (substance abuse, street, domestic violence, etc) and academic barriers (general literacy, verb tenses, speaking, listening, reading, writing, etc.)
 - Fill out and hand in attendance sheets to coordinator.
- Teach stage-based ESL
 - Prepare teaching materials for varying levels of proficiency and varying levels of engagement
 - Teach in a classroom setting that ranges from 5-15 participants between the ages of 16 and 24 after a 1-2 week period of ESL classroom observation
- Facilitate computer-based education
 - Use Roca Computer Lab for educational programming (i.e. building resumes in English for non-English speakers who need to find work)
